

# 2024 PAMUN Tentative Conference Schedule April 26, 2024

### 8:00-8:30 Registration

<u>8:30 - 9:00</u> **Opening Ceremony** Welcome Secretaries General. They will introduce the chair/co-chair of each committee and the Richwoods high school ambassadors (1-2 minutes).

## 9:05-10:00 Committee Session I

- 1. Introduction by Chair and Co-Chairs
- 2. Roll call for all participants Present/present and voting (in alphabetical order by country name). Chair does the roll call. Co-chair marks down answers
- 3. Ice breaker Hot Seat (1 or 2 rounds)
- 4. Opening speeches In alphabetical order by country name. Each speech approx. one minute or less (give 10 second warning at a minute)
- 5. After each speech the chair asks "are you open to any points of information". Instruct the presenter that they can say "yes, any and all," "yes" and specify a number, or "no. The delegate yields its time to the chair".

## <u>10:00-10:15</u> Break

## 10:15 - 11:15 Committee Session II

- 1. Chair reopens debate
- 2. Delegates motion and vote on things like moderated caucuses and unmoderated caucuses to start a working paper.
- 3. Give each group of delegates a few copies of this Guide to Writing Resolutions. Give the delegates 15-20 minutes to write an outline resolution. It can be very basic.

## 12:00-12:25 General Assembly for Keynote Speaker

## <u>12:25 - 1:00</u> Crisis

- 1. Explain to the delegates that there has been a crisis and you will need to pause your work on the resolutions. Take 10 minutes or so to propose a solution to your crisis. Write your solution in the form of a paragraph. Each committee needs to choose a solution and the whole group will vote on the best solution.
- 2. Have a delegate(s) from each committee come up to read their proposed solution and take questions. See if there are any additional comments on the floor.

## 1:00-2:00 Committee Session III

- 1. Explain to delegates that the purpose of committee session 3 is to finish up and present resolutions.
- 2. Have 1-2 delegates from each group come up to the front and read their resolution.
- 3. Have 2 more members (can be the same or different) from each bloc to answer questions.
- 4. Secure the doors for voting. Vote on each of the resolutions. Any resolution with 50% or more of the votes passes. Clap for each resolution that passes.
- 5. Right after voting, the Chair/Co-Chair chooses awards (Best Delegate, Outstanding Delegate, Honorable Mention) <u>and</u> optional 2-3 informal awards. Informal awards are presented in committees before going to the gym for the closing ceremonies. Formal awards are presented in the closing ceremony.

<u>2:00-2:15</u> **Closing Ceremony** Each chair and co-chair takes one minute to describe the work that was done in their committees (the topics covered, the resolutions written, the resolutions) and hand awards before going on to the next person.
